What is A Impound Repossession. (Including Body & Repair Shop Recovery)

<u>Definition:</u> to confine within an enclosure or within limits.

Due to the time involved to recover impounded collateral:

- 1. Due to time involvement, Impound, Body & Repair Shop recoveries are billed at the "Recovery Agency Involuntary Rate" (see #2, #3, #4, #5 below)
- 2. May involve fronting fees on behalf of the client. Agent may charge a surcharge for this service. In lieu of that, agent may require overnight repayment of advanced fees.
- 3. May involve time dealing with law enforcement to obtain the vehicle release.
- 4. May involve time interacting with tow yard, and once the vehicle is released, the stand-by time for the vehicle to be accessible.
- 5. May involve negotiation of fees on behalf of the client at body or repair shops.
- 6. May involve using specialty transportation equipment for the recovery of the collateral which may be inoperable. Vehicle may or may not be moveable with standard wheel-lift tow vehicle and additional charges may apply.
- 7. In some cases, impound lots **WILL NOT** allow agent to inspect vehicle prior to payment and release. Agent is not held responsible for value of vehicle under those circumstances.
- 8. Requires the correct documents from the client.
